

Age of Medicaid Enrollees




In Ohio, Medicaid covers:




Eligibility levels as a percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)

Others are students, caretakers, or dealing with a chronic health condition.




Preventive care and treating conditions early reduce the need for high-cost emergency room
