Health Recovery Services

HRS is partnered with Ohio Health in a HRSA funded project that creates an integrated, addictions team composed of Ohio Health staff and HRS. The addictions team meets daily and works out of the hospital and physicians building on the campus of Oblesen Hospital as well as in the community. The community focus is outreach to bring those with addiction needs into treatment and support services. The hospital focus is to seek out patients who present through the emergency room or are hospitalized due to primary health conditions, who also are suffering from the disease of substance use disorder. The addictions team engages them and provides immediate access to appropriate treatment services via a warm handoff through face to face interaction. The addictions team is now fully operational and providing a much needed service to our community.

Our men completed their community give back project by adopting 9 families and providing them with a complete Thanksgiving meal. We worked with Ohio Means Jobs (Shawn Stover) and Athens County Children Services through Athens juvenile court (Zach Saunders) in acquiring these families. Our residents delivered these meals to each deserving family this past Saturday.
