Women for Recovery would like to share the following agency updates:

CENSUS

We continue to have referrals primarily from treatment centers, SEORJ, and Marysville along with recommendations from local probation and parole officers. Our current census is 7.

FACILITY/ACTIVITIES

- Regular activities in our meeting space include acupuncture, qigong, trauma-sensitive yoga, strength & conditioning, and music therapy.
- We are working with Rural Action monthly as residents participate in a trail building/trail reconstruction project on a segment of the Buckeye Trail. This is a grant-funded project through Rural Action where the focus is women building camaraderie and learning new skills together.
- We participated as volunteers at the Athens Marathon on Sunday, April 19th. This is the fourth year we have been able to help, and all but one of our current residents plus some former residents took at least one shift.
- We will attend the Calliope Feminist Choir performance on Friday, May 8th
- We are the financial recipients of a donation from an Athens, Ohio Roller Derby home match on Saturday, May 16th – we were selected as the recipient by one of the Derby team members.

OHIO UNIVERSITY INVOLVEMENT

We have had two full-year social work interns who will complete their terms at the end of April. We separately hosted two semester-long students in the fall and again in the spring; they have performed their service learning/community engagement with Serenity Grove.
