

HRS Report for AHV Board Meeting 6/22/26

HRS is currently preparing the quarterly reports for the State Opioid Response (SOR) program.

We recently received tentative approval for funding for the Fatherhood for the *Responsible Fatherhood Initiative: Strong Fathers, Strong Families*. The project will be implemented in Hocking County and will expand upon existing family-focused programming. The grant will enhance HRS's ability to strengthen father engagement, family communication, and family resilience while reducing reliance on limited local funding sources.

We have also submitted Requests for Information (RFIs) for two new funding opportunities: the Women's Residential Pilot Program and the Women's Hub and Spoke Program. These opportunities could provide funding to expand residential and integrated treatment services for women with substance use disorders and enhance the continuum of care available within our service area.

In addition, we are working on the application for Ohio's State Opioid and Stimulant Response (SOS) 4.0 Grant funding opportunity which is due Wednesday.
